FAREWELL TO GROBZIETHEN on 21st and 22nd September from 14.00 to 18.00

Dear Art lovers, Friends, Collectors of Karl Menzen's works,

There will be an opportunity to visit his studio and workshop for one last time on **21st and 22nd September from 14.00 to 18.00**. Due to gentrification after 16 successful years in Fuldastrasse in Neukölln and 15 years in Kreuzberg he was forced to move there. It became a place where he felt at home, and where he worked till the very end.

The door to this studio, which was first opened to visitors in April 2016, will close at six o'clock in the evening on 22nd September. The studio will then be moved to smaller premises at Neue Hochstraße 8, 13347 Berlin-Wedding.

The farewell will take place just like the opening with a mobile espresso. The trumpeter Richard Koch, who dedicated one of his compositions to Karl on his latest CD, will provide the musical accompaniment.

The address is Karl-Marx-Str. 113, 12529 Schönefeld /Großziethen. Buses 742 and 744 stop at Erlenweg just before the entrance. There is plenty of room to leave bikes and motorbikes in the yard in front of the studio. Please park cars in Erlenweg or nearby streets.
